4. Challenges in implementation of MDMS in Madhya Pradesh

- Less coverage of children against enrolment.
- > Delay in construction of 4763 kitchen-cum-stores.
- Less Annual data and monthly data entries in MIS portal.

> Only 0.03% of schools are reported daily data in AMS.

5. Best Practices being followed in the State for effective implementation of the scheme:-

- > Milk served to primary class children three days a week from State's resources.
- > E-transfer of cooking cost in the account of SHGs.
- Additional contribution of Rs.1000/- by State towards honorarium per month per cook-cum-helper.
- > E-transfer of Honorarium in the account of to cook-cum-helpers.
- Mothers, Antyoday Card Holders, Senior Citizens taste the meal daily.
- One Task Manager and three Quality Monitors inspect at least 50 schools in a month.
- > Social Audit carried out by Gram Sabha in its quarterly meetings.
- > Medical contingency plan in every school for any untoward incident.
- > Ag-mark and branded ingredients used in mid day meal.
- Sample of meal kept in sealed tiffin for 24 hrs.
- > Dining halls constructed through convergence with MNREGS etc.
- > Hand wash units constructed in schools in convergence with Panch Parmeshwar.
