1. Approved outlay for 2021-22 is Rs. 139.67 Lakh (Central Share including for summer vacations as one time measure due to Covid -19 pandemic). The UT of Lakshadweep was granted permission to utilize the Unspent Balance from the previous year amounting to Rs.27.08 Lakh against the Ad-hoc Recurring Central Assistance for the year 2021-22.

4. Challenges in implementation of PM (POSHAN) in UT of Lakshadweep

- 1) There is a delay of 2 to 4 months in fund transfer from UT HQ upto schools in the Islands.
- 2) The UT of Lakshadweep has submitted the proposal for release of balance of 1st Instalment but IFD has made observations on the proposal and therefore information is being sought from the UT Administration and the same is awaited
- 3) Testing of food samples have never been done in the UT.
- 4) Social Audit under PM (POSHAN) is yet to be initiated.
- 5) Only 27% children were screened under Health check up programme and 12% children distributed IFA tablets during 2020-21.

5. Best Practices being followed in the UT of Lakshadweep for effective implementation of the scheme:-

- 1) Meals under PM (POSHAN) is served to all children of Pre-Primary & Class IXth to XIIth from UT's own resources.
- 2) Additional contribution in cooking cost of Rs.16.52 in Primary & Rs. 11.70 in Upper Primary over & above the Central Assistance.
- 3) Every day either egg, Chicken, Fish or Mutton is served and fruits/milk/any other items are served thrice a week from UT resources.
- 4) Payment of additional Honorarium of Rs. 8500 to cook-cum-helpers from UT's own resources over & above Central Assistance.
- 5) All cook cum helper under PM (POSHAN) are receiving honorarium through their respective bank accounts only.
- 6) Health checkup of all cook cum helper is mandatory for getting license from FSSAI to work in PM (POSHAN) Kitchens
