Group-I



Initial requirement

- Land / Area for developing a kitchen garden in the school premises.
- Proper boundary fencing/wall.
- Adequate water supply
- Agricultural equipments

Action Plan

- SMC meeting for developing kitchen garden should be conducted well in advance for preparing plan of action.
- Plan for procurement of seeds; equipments, etc in block level.
- Co-ordination meeting of concerned Departments before rainy season and prepare action plan for developing kitchen garden.

The Agriculture/Horticulture Department shall supply required seeds on free of cost to schools.

The H.M/SMC shall take the assistance of Gram Panchayat/Community for developing kitchen garden.

School grant/Maintenance grant may be used for developing kitchen garden in the school.

- Orientation programme for H.M, Teachers, Community, CCH & Children about the importance of kitchen garden in the schools where ever it is proposed.
- Choosing the right vegetables suitable for the soil and climate and which can be grown easily and having nutritious value.
- Maintenance of proper records of input and output of kitchen garden.

Recommendations

- Kitchen garden should be encouraged to supplement the MDM; not to replace the regular items already being provided daily on daily basis.
- Convergence with other Departments like Agriculture, Horticulture, Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Panchayat Raj, Rural water supply etc.
- Inclusion of kitchen garden as a main part of "Social Useful Productivity Work" (SUPW) in Co-Curricular activities in the schools.

- Kitchen garden should not disturb the play area of children in the schools.
- Guidelines regarding developing kitchen garden in schools should be prepared and communicated by the Govt./Department.
- School level committee involving children, teachers, community, SMC members & CCH for maintenance.

- Recognition of best performing schools by awarding certificates/cash incentives to schools.
- Showcasing the success stories to motivate others to develop kitchen gardens.
- Involvement of children should be on voluntary basis.
- Kitchen Garden activities should be included in School Development Plan.

Overall supervision by the SMC at school level.
